

Who Could Sell Liquor under HB 2556?

HB 2556 defines what retail businesses could obtain a license to sell Strong Beer, Wine and Spirits. The definition includes specific NAICS codes. Here is information provided by the Kansas Department of Revenue regarding the NAICS codes.

The following count is based on sales tax registration data, with the exception of 445310 Beer Wine and Liquor Stores - that data is from Kansas retail liquor license (753). The count should be considered an approximation of the number of stores as not all physical locations are reported to us and a business may not notify us when a store is closed.

The count is the number of physical location stores (vs. number of businesses) registered with the department for sales tax. Also, included is 447190, Other gasoline stores and 452112 Discount stores to the list.
